RYLA INFORMATION SHEET

October - Send your money in to reserve your students places at camp. RYLA is a first-come, first-served system. Write checks payable to Rotary District 5320 and note RYLA on the check. Mail to: Rotary District 5320, 1619 N. Brian St., Suite B, Orange, CA 2026 cost is \$615 per camper.

<u>November</u> - distribute the RYLA brochure, RYLA letter, the RYLA WANTS YOU letter, and the STUDENT QUESTIONNAIRE to counselors at schools, YMCA, Interact chairs or to anyone that might help in obtaining campers.

FEBRUARY 15 - DEADLINE FOR SENDING MONEY TO THE DISTRICT OFFICE

<u>January - February</u> - the RYLA registration committee will be sending out the contact information of those campers who have registered. You need to begin contacting and interviewing those students. There is a list of Proposed Interview Questions on the website at http://ryla5320.org/rotarian-forms/ryla-club-guidelines

<u>February - March</u> - Final interviews with students. Evaluate them with a judging system - is there good eye contact? How is the handshake? Or by the criteria your Club sets.

<u>March 1-7</u> - Contact your winning students and welcome them to RYLA. Ask if they or their parents have any further questions.

<u>March 15</u> - Last date to notify the registration committee of your final selections/alternates. Once we receive your final selection we will contact the campers with a Welcome Letter and additional instructions on what to bring and the Boojum (ropes course) medical release information.

March 18 - Drop dead date for any substitution from your alternate list

Make sure your campers/students have transportation on Friday and back home on Sunday after camp.

Invite your campers/students to your Club so they can meet and thank the Rotarians that sponsored them.
